If school is closed due to inclement weather, the Elementary School can use up to five (5) Flexible Instruction Days (FIDs) in a school year. FIDs will occur remotely, according to the schedule listed below. Teachers will post their Google Meet links on their Google Classroom homepages as well as ClassDojo. During remote FIDs, students must login to the teacher's Google Classroom at the assigned time.

Classes will run synchronously, which means students will be joining their classes live using Google Meets. During these meets, teachers will check for students' understanding of the lesson and take attendance. Detailed schedules and assignments will be sent home in advance.
