KNOW YOUR RIGHTS

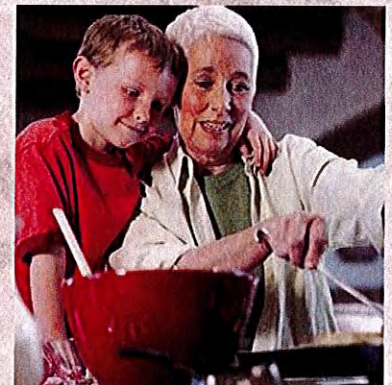
On July 22, 1987, the Stewart B. McKinney Homeless Assistance Act became public law. This was the first comprehensive federal law dealing with the problems of homelessness in America.

The Education for Children and Youth Experiencing Homelessness, authorized under the McKinney-Vento Act is designed to address the needs of homeless children and youths and ensure educational rights and protections for these children and youths.
