## YOU AND YOUR FAMILY ARE VERY IMPORTANT

If you or members of your family work in agriculture and have recently moved, your children or you may qualify to receive free services from the Pennsylvania MEP.

### 01. Goal

To ensure that all children and young agricultural worker achieve challenging academic standards and graduate with a high school diploma or complete a High School Equivalency Diploma



### 02. Services

Educational services such as tutoring and summer programs provided by school districts are available to students in the program and are free of charge.



### 03. Eligibility

The requirements are:

- The student or the young agricultural worker must have moved from one school district to another in the past 36 months maximum.
- One of the parents, close relatives or the young agricultural worker must have worked or is working in a temporary job in agriculture or fishing
- The student or young agricultural worker must be under 21 years of age and must not have graduated from high school or similar.
